# GWD

- The space between the shed and the building needs to be blocked. Students get off the bus and hide there. Then they wander unsupervised in the back of the building.
- Very short notice for new students, with little-to no information.
- Discipline concerns for major (physical) and recurring offenders. They have been suspended and the behavior has not changed. It was repeated at the first recess back. They were suspended a second time. This is being addressed.
- We still have a water-bottle filling station closed due to lead contamination. Is there a plan for repairing? Can the filling station be moved to safe plumbing?
- Truancy Concern: there is a lack of recourse for chronic absenteeism. This could be addressed by May.
- Crews were working on the water heater, but it is STILL making loud noises in hallways. This is being addressed.
- Two Factor Authentication concerns, records requests, personal information available to public request.

### LHS

### • Concerns about losing paras at LMS with the new addition of a new position.

- LMS echos the concern about two-factor authentication and unknowns related to using personal phones. This should be rolled out at the next full work day and not on a regular school day.
- Still concerned about heat This is being addressed.

#### LHS

- Stipends not being equitable for club advisors v. coaches
- Students are opting to take online classes instead of in-person classes because the auto-graded classes are easier and can be done in a rather short period of time (without a lot of learning). Meanwhile, our Google Classroom online classes taught by teachers have very low enrollment.
- Administrators are taking a harder line with students on grades as it relates to athletics and activities. While this is a good thing, there are concerns with consistency and communication. What is the line for students? And is there a written policy that is clear and easy to understand?
